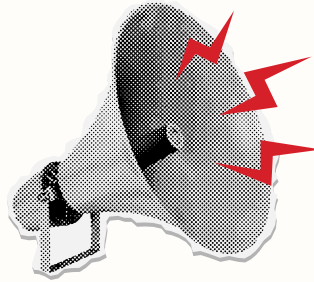

- Provides information as requested to IAM local political action committees
- Coordinates local committees with the appropriate government contacts
- Organizes member involvement in Federal elections
- Provides political advocacy and lobbying training
- Assists with organizing petitions and awareness campaigns
- Supports efforts to protect workers' rights through political action
